

SNORKELING

Tips for preparing

VISIT the dive center for advice on snorkeling techniques, access points and local conditions.

LEARN about local snorkeling spots, seek out beach access with calm waters as well as easy entry & exit access points.

PRACTICE in calm waters to make sure you are fit & ready to snorkel in open waters.

Before snorkeling

Inform the reception before going to snorkeling and after returning from snorkeling.

There is no lifeguard at the beach. You enter the water at your own risk.

Check the current, tides and weather conditions prior to snorkeling.

Wear brightly colored rash vest or a life jacket and wear plenty of sunscreen even when it is cloudy.

When snorkeling

There is always a current(s) in the lagoon, the direction(s) and strength(s) of which are affected by the season, wind, weather, tides, and other factors.

Retain your energy. Snorkeling should be relaxing, swim slowly and gently.

It is best to know your physical limits and not to exceed them.

Always take special care if you enter the lagoon at night.

Always snorkel with a buddy and keep in close proximity to the shore.

DO NOT snorkel

When there are large waves.

When there are strong currents.

In areas where there is boat traffic.
